A Terms of Reference tells us about the group, what it is for, and how it will work



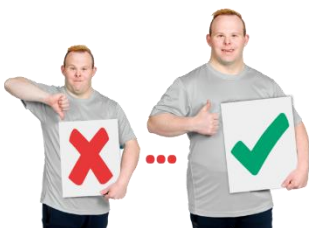
1. Purpose (What the group is for)



The purpose of the group is to bring people together to make things better, with and for, the people we support



We want to work with, and listen to what matters to, the people we support



This will help develop our services

2. Accountability



This group is to talk about services for people with a disability



Changes to policy or strategy will be put into a report and sent to the Adult Social Care and Public Health Committee



This group cannot make final decisions about policy

3. Reporting



The group will provide reports to :

- ✓ The Adult Care and Health Directorate
- ✓ The All-Age Disability Partnership Board



The information from the group will help both to develop policy and strategy

4. Principles



Each member of the group agrees to work co-operatively and:



- ✓ Be advocates for people we support



- ✓ Allow debate and discussion in the group



- ✓ Think independently and focus on facts



- ✓ Be honest, transparent and tell the truth



- ✓ Celebrate achievements



- ✓ Include everyone



- ✓ Focus on results that will allow change and get better

5. Roles and Responsibilities



To work together to plan and improve day services



Share feedback and issues about day services from people we support, parents/carers, staff and volunteers



Encourage services to work with community providers to allow volunteering, training and employment opportunities, that bring life skills for the people supported and their families



To share information from meetings to stakeholders



Keep updated with developments and new ideas to help the service respond to them



Take part in a self-review every year

Admin Support



Group members should attend at least half of the meetings



If a member cannot attend, they can send someone else on their behalf

7. Payment

Members are expected to respect confidentiality of some topics discussed at the meetings



Documents and the notes from the meetings, can be shared unless members are told they are confidential or in draft format

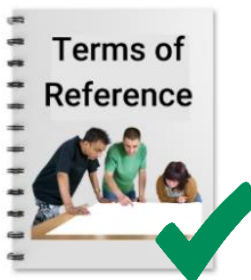


The group is not for dealing with individual complaints - these should be dealt with in the usual manner

9. Administration Arrangements



A Chair and Co-chair will be chosen by the group on its first meeting



The Terms of Reference for the group will be confirmed at the first meeting



Meetings will take place every 2 months



Meetings will take place at an accessible venue chosen by the group



Zoom or Teams will be made available for those unable to attend in person



Meetings will be in private to enable an open and honest discussion



Agendas to be prepared in Easy Read format and sent out by admin 1 week before the meeting



Action notes to be prepared in Easy Read format and sent out by admin 2 weeks after the meeting



The Terms of Reference, Membership, Chair and Co-chair will be reviewed by the group every year
