## Day Opportunities



Our Day Opportunities provide vocational training to develop skills, knowledge and professional qualifications.

### Dale Farm

Dale Farm is located on the banks of the River Dee overlooking North Wales Coast. The farm uses all aspects of horticulture, planting, growing organic fruit and vegetables in fields and polytunnels. They also produce their own honey from bee keeping.

### Royden Park

Royden Park has 250 acres of beautiful park land and provides teaching and assistance in angling, running horticultural and conservation projects, log splitting and first steps to floristry in partnership with Wirral Metropolitan College.

### Best Bites

Best Bites operates over four locations across the Wirral and provides support in catering and hospitality in a real working environment, giving people the skills and knowledge to move into employment, voluntary work and increase life and social skills. Best Bites work in partnership with Wirral Metropolitan College.
