The Challenge Why was the support needed? - Brief Outline

- ✓ JC found lockdowns during the COVID-19 pandemic very challenging
- ✓ JC had moved in with her sister and family following a bereavement

Our Role What actions did we take? – Brief bullet points

- ✓ Staff worked with JC to find a bubble and environment that would be best suited to her
- ✓ Staff set up tailor made activities to suit JC's needs and interests
- ✓ JC was provided with a tablet to enable her to access the internet to help with her feelings of isolation
- ✓ JC was supported to attend local shops and buy her lunch
 as she did before COVD-19
- ✓ JC was supported to request more days at her centre as it was felt this would decrease her levels of anxiety
