1) Introductions and Apologies

welcomed everyone and apologies were noted.

There were 2 new faces from Royden Park now people are taking turns coming to meetings. The Zoom link was kept open for anyone else who wanted to join, although no-one did.

2) Minutes from the last meeting and matters arising

Everyone checked through the minutes on screen share and agreed they were right. There were some matters arising and updates.

Transport

The Day Services Coproduction Group are now looking at the problems and there are 2 different parts:

- 1) Home to Centre transport in the mornings and afternoons
- 2) Getting people to activities and events during the day

Cambridge Road minibus

advised people at her centre say they are fed up with asking and getting no response. They asked her to mention it again as she was coming here today. Will be attending the next few meetings of the Day Services Coproduction Group so will be sure to mention it there.

It was agreed to make a note of people nominated today -If all are happy to take part, the group can then vote when everyone is here. advised she will not be involved with the Day Services Coproduction Group going forward - she is handing over to attending the next few meetings so there will still be familiar faces. asked if there would still be a pre-meeting to prepare and discuss the agenda before. a Service Co-ordinator at Dale Farm, has been doing meeting preparation work with people. said this just needs to be coordinated with as Co-Chair and as the first stand-in. 3) Terms of Reference and Representation read out the Terms of Reference on screen share and it was agreed that quite a lot needed to be changed. Terms of Reference The yearly review due in September has not happened for some time and Wirral Evolutions are now part of Wirral Council, not a separate company. This means that some of the terms and language have become very out of date. The group began working through the document page by page and made some suggestions for changes to words and easy read symbols. also noted that the point about coproduction focused only on recruitment. People attending services can be involved in so much more, especially now there is the Day Services Coproduction Group.

There was some discussion about whether people supported would still be involved in recruitment now Wirral Evolutions is part of the Council again, for example, being on the interview panel if recruiting a management role.

It was suggested that these Terms of Reference should be looked at by people attending the services in smaller groups when there is more time.

After making the changes mentioned today, a copy will be forwarded to the centres so people can discuss it at their regular meetings and make any other suggestions or give feedback.

4) Development Day and Training

This item was moved on to the agenda for the March meeting.

(People from Royden Park had to leave early at 11:48)


There was a discussion about people staying for the whole meeting, not regularly arriving late or leaving early.
